ISSUE

House Bill 1349A allowing mountain bikes in the wilderness is up for a subcommittee vote tomorrow. Your IPWA Board OPPOSES this legislation.

IPWA Volunteers, Members, and Friends:

The Indian Peaks Wilderness Alliance strives to stay apolitical and focus strictly on our core mission of "Preserving and Protecting the Indian Peaks and James Peak Wilderness Areas." But at times we must stand up for the basic values in which we believe.

There is a new threat to the National Wilderness Preservation System. HR 1349A is a short-sighted, single focus, special interest legislative bill headed for a House Natural Resources subcommittee vote tomorrow December 13. This bill, if passed, will overturn the basis of our current wilderness system by allowing unrestricted new intrusions from mountain bikes and other wheeled devices to occur.
