Although the initial proposed budget bill mandating the sale of millions of acres of public lands has recently undergone revision (and has been ruled against by the Senate Parliamentarian), the fight is definitely not over. Public land sale is still on the table and the proponents of public land sales are showing no signs of letting up.

Forest Service lands that border Indian Peaks Wilderness were on the initial slate of "to be sold", and may yet be again. These lands currently provide critical buffer for our local Wilderness Areas and important wildlife habitat and recreational access.
