## Some Highlights include:

- Bear activity is still high. Bring bear canisters for dispersed/backcountry camping and use bear lockers at campgrounds. Report all bear interactions to CPW at (303) 291-7227.
- Pawnee Campground is closed. Brainard Lake Recreational Area is open until October 14. "Summer" Regulations Apply until November 15. Dogs must always be on hand-held leash. Dispersed camping is only allowed north of the South St. Vrain Creek.
- Indian Peaks Wilderness Permit season is winding down. Permits are not required after September 15. Permits are required year round for day and overnight trips for organized groups of 8-12 people. Campfires are prohibited in most areas. Other wilderness regulations apply.
